Nene's Annual Holiday Toy Drive


Our 3rd annual toy drive raised over \$3,000 in toy donations. We again sponsored Hope for the Holidays in Atlantic City, NJ.

Shore Medical Center's Emergency Department Transformation


RPMF's next project with Shore Medical Center is the transformation of 12 Emergency Department patient bays. These bays are currently separated only by curtains, which may make patients hesitant to speak openly with their care team about sensitive health issues. Likewise, those in pain or distress may feel self-conscious about being overheard by others. With the support of RPMF, through your generous donations, SMC will be converting these areas into glass-enclosed, private rooms, modeled after the RPMF Specialty Care Room. This upgrade will protect privacy, reduce noise, and provide a wuiet, reassuring space where patients can rest, recover, and feel safe while receiving care.

Pending state approval, we anticipate completion in 2026. The result will be a more modern, compassionate Emergency Dept – one that reflects our shared belief that families in our community deserve access to the highest level of care.



In 2025, RPMF supported Shore Medical Center to renovate their Family Waiting Room in the ER department. This renovation provides a comfortable and child-friendly environment for families to wait to hear from medical staff on the condition of their loved ones.





Renee Parker Monihan Early Childhood Endowment Fund at the Marjorie & Lewis Katz JCC

In 2025, this fund was able to provide a disabled toddler with a year's worth of tuition to the Early Childhood Education Center at the Katz JCC, where Renee also attended as an infant and toddler.
